The staff nurse provides patient care and medical service operations for Alcove Health.

- 3. Agree with and be willing to uphold the Statement of Faith, Statement of Principle, and the policies of the center.
- 4. Holds a current Registered Nurse's License in good standing with the State Medical Board.

- 6. Is dependable, capable of following through on commitments, and respects confidentiality.
- 7. Ability to complete Limited OB ultrasound training provided by CNP.
- 8. Preferably a professional background in OB/GYN or neonatology.

MAJOR DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. NURSING CARE 90%

- a. Meet with the patient and record medical history related to the pregnancy test and health history forms. Perform pregnancy testing and provide POP and/or PNV.
- b. Evaluate patient for qualifying ultrasound exam, explain procedure, and all consents. Provide Limited OB ultrasounds in accordance with medical P&P's and standards of care. Explain all findings to patient, documents findings & education in medical record.
- c. Provide patient and family with pregnancy counseling, abortion education, pregnancy precautions, and physician referrals. Record notes and communicate with clinic team members as appropriate.
- d. Provide health information to patient and family regarding sexual and prenatal health
- e. Provide patient follow-up by various means and fax records to appropriate medical facilities.
- f. Ensure that all patient ultrasound images have been properly added to patient chart, all necessary documentation is complete, and all necessary forms have been properly uploaded to patient chart
- g. Ensure that medical equipment is properly operated, stored, and maintained. Provide a clean work environment.
- h. Assist team with content creation for blogs, videos, and social media posts.
- i. Always maintain patient confidentiality.

- a. Comply with state and professional licensing to include any annual continuing education requirements.
- b. Up to date CPR certification.
- c. Attend annual ultrasound refresher training
- d. Attend and obtain annual ultrasound skills signoff by Medical Director
- e. Annual review and compliance with center policies and procedures, infection control regulations, and safety procedures.
- f. Participate in staff meetings, medical team and client services team meetings, Care Net Peninsula fundraising events, community outreach, etc. as appropriate.
- g. Provide support to the other clinic team members, including taking appointment calls, phone triage, follow ups, and volunteer support. Help maintain inventory of supplies.
